

1.1 CODE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1.1.1 Members must own a Jeep™.
- 1.1.2 Members shall adhere to the principles of Tread Lightly™, and act in support of the association's role in improving and maintaining the areas we use. Members will respect all private, federal, state, and county property.
- 1.1.3 Members will abide by federal and state laws pertaining to the possession, consumption, and distribution of drugs and alcohol. Members will abide by event-specific prohibitions on such substances per the discretion of the NVJA.
- 1.1.4 Members will abide by federal and state laws governing the possession, transport, discharge, or any other use of a firearm or other weapon while participating in NVJA activities. Members will abide by event-specific prohibitions on such items per the discretion of the NVJA.
- 1.1.5 Members agree to conduct themselves appropriately and respectfully, with unruly, disrespectful, criminal, or otherwise socially offensive behaviors subject to review and/or discipline per the discretion of the NVJA.
- 1.1.6 Members found in flagrant violation of the Member's Code of Responsibilities are subject to immediate review by the Board of Directors. Corrective actions include suspension, expulsion, and in the case of criminal acts, notification of the appropriate authorities.
- 1.1.7 No Member, Officer, or Director of the Club may participate in, or attempt to influence any decision by the Club affecting his or her own personal business interests, or otherwise use his or her official position for personal gain.
